

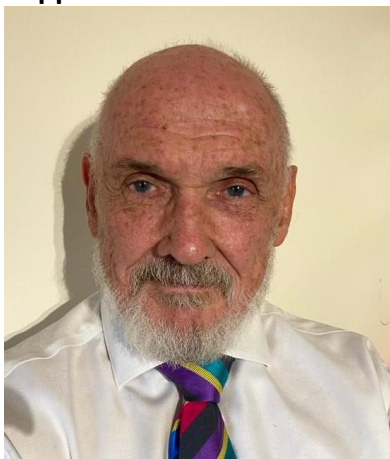
The care and protection of children, young people and adults involved in Church activities is the responsibility of everyone who participates in the life of the Church
